In 2013 served as Chairman of the Anti-Doping Board. He was appointed Chairman of The Local Governance Board and Chairman of the Refugee Appeals Board In 2013. In 2014 he was also appointed as Umpire presiding over the Social Security Appeals Board.

On the 5th June 2015 he was appointed a Magistrate and assigned duties in the Court of Magistrates (Malta) and Court of Magistrates (Gozo) as a Court of Criminal Judicature.

Magistrate Mifsud is also the author of a number of books on politics, crime and terrorism with the latest book published in 2014 Terror Footprints.
